4.	Is the ladder less than 2m high and of composite or metal construction? (only composite ladders should be used near existing live services) Does the step ladder comply with:	Yes
5.	EN13 / BSEN131 with a working platform of at least 400 x 400 mm. or BS 2037 class 1, with a sign confirming the top 3 steps must not be used? Domestic grade (Class 3) ladders are not permitted.	Yes
